

sli.do Information on sli.do for NSC 2017

Q: What is sli.do?

A: sli.do is the online platform that the NOAA Satellite Conference (NSC) is using this year to engage the audience directly. The audience can use sli.do to respond to poll questions posed during panel discussions and town hall forums, and ask questions of panelists and town hall leaders at appropriate times throughout the conference. It is pronounced sly-doe.

Q: What is the benefit of sli.do?

A: sli.do makes it easy for NOAA to engage the audience and obtain real-time feedback that can guide the discussion of panelists. One of the features of sli.do enables participants to select questions from other audience members that are also of interest to them, or reply with additional information. This will allow moderators of NSC panel discussions and town hall forums to focus on high-interest questions. For those questions that there is not time to answer, NOAA will try to respond to them at a later date.

Q: Is sli.do the only way that attendees can ask questions during the program?

A: No. We will allow participants to pose questions directly over microphones if a question is particularly long, technical, or specific, or a participant is unable to access sli.do. We prefer the audience engage with us via sli.do if at all possible. Attendees can connect to sli.do with their Twitter handle if they wish.

Q: Will participants need to download sli.do?

A: No. The sli.do platform for the conference can be accessed online using any computer or smartphone with an Internet connection and web browser.

Q: Do participants have to create an account? Is personal information stored?

A: No, sli.do does not require the use of an account or store personal data. You may volunteer your name and/or organization as part of asking questions or replying, but that is optional.

Q: What is the best way to access sli.do?

A: There is a link to sli.do from the official app for the conference. Once you open the NSC app, select the "Live Polling" button to enter the sli.do platform. The event code to enter, #5699, is on attendee name tags.

Q: Can participants ask questions anonymously?

A: Yes. While we prefer that participants provide a name for follow-up if necessary, participants have the option to ask questions anonymously if it is particularly sensitive by selecting the appropriate checkbox, or leaving the name field blank.

Q: I was quick to respond to a poll question, but after hearing more from the panel I was persuaded differently. Can I change my answer?

A: Yes, you may change your response to a poll question for the duration that it is open.

Q: Are sli.do polling questions available in Spanish or another language?

A: No, but questions or replies can be posted to sli.do in Spanish.
